**Emirates** has announced that it is increasing its commitment to Japan with the launch of daily, non-stop flights between Dubai and Tokyo International Airport (Haneda Airport) on 3 June 2013. Haneda will be the second Tokyo airport served by Emirates' non-stop flights.

**Air Arabia** is proud to announce its new destination to Iraq: Baghdad, starting from USD 500 and the flights are effective from 11<sup>th</sup> March 2013.

**British Airways** (operated by Comair) has advised they will no longer accept firearms, sporting rifles, spear guns and crossbows of any kind for transport effective 28<sup>th</sup> February 2013.

**British Airways** will be commencing with flights between OR Tambo and Maputo International effective 6<sup>th</sup> May 2013. The flight schedule will comprise of daily flights, with double daily service on Tuesdays and Saturdays.

**British Airways** has advised that the UK Government now requires advance passenger information (APIS) on all international routes into and out of the UK, effective 13<sup>th</sup> February 2013, collection of this data will be enforced at check-in and ba.com will prompt customers to add this information in 'Manage My Booking'. **Kulula.com** is spreading its wings to East London flying everyday, except on Saturdays from OR Tambo International starting on the 1<sup>st</sup> March 2013.

**Kulula** has introduced flexibility on all its flights, allowing passengers to exercise some freedom when travelling with the airline. Securing a flexi ticket will allow passengers free changes before departure, stand-by permission on any earlier flight, a 100% refund before departure and only a R100 no-show fee (excluding VAT). These special fares are only available through travel agents. **AfricaStay**, in association with Mango, will operate charter flights to Zanzibar, commencing 12 March 2013. The charters, operated with a B737-800, and will operate on Tuesdays, with a same-day return in a similar time slot to the Zanzibar flights formerly operated by 1time. The aircraft has capacity for 185 passengers. The flights would be well priced and would be cheaper than indirect services and that it would be possible to book flights only.

Malaysia Airlines offers extra baggage allowance: Passengers flying with Malaysia Airlines will benefit from an additional 10kg free checked baggage allowance and reduced excess baggage charges for all classes effective 14 February 2013. This benefits passengers flying worldwide to and from all points operated by the carrier, however, does not apply to code share flights and for those travelling to and from Los Angeles. The piece system concept allows each passenger to check-in two pieces of baggage weighing a maximum of 32 kgs, regardless of class of travel. The new checked baggage allowance is now 30kg for economy class, 40kg for business class and 50kgs for first class. Charges for excess checked baggage weight will be calculated depending on zone of travel with a fixed rate applied for every five kg block of excess baggage weight, and the rate for excess weight is RM30, RM60 and RM90.

**Air Malawi** has confirmed that the airline is no longer operating as a result of voluntary liquidation. When first announced that the airline entered voluntary liquidation in December, it said that it was the intention of the government of Malawi to let the airline continue its operations under the liquidator.

#### British Airways Baggage Policy:

Checked baggage (this is loaded into the airplanes cargo hold):

 Customers travelling o BA flights are entitled to a free checked baggage allowance which is determined by cabin and traveler type. This is restricted to dimensions of 90cm(I) x 75cm(w) and 43cm(h) and 23kg in weight.

Heavy bag charge:

Bags that weigh more than 23kg but less than 32kg will be charged a heavy bag charge.

Bags considered cargo:

 Weigh more than 32kg must be transported as cargo. Bags carried in addition to the free checked baggage allowance will incur an extra bag fee.

Hand baggage (baggage that you carry on board with you):

 Is restricted to 1 piece per customer, weighing no more than 7kg with dimensions: 56cmx36cmx23cm (115cm) + handbag / laptop or briefcase.
