Emirates Airlines new A380 airbus landed at OR Tambo International for the first time on the 1st October 2011. The airbus is an amazing aircraft and will be flying the JHB – Dubai leg at 14h10 every day. This airbus consists of 14 first class seats, 76 business class seats and 427 economy class seats (a total of 517 seats).

Air France has introduced a new Business Class cabin which is currently available on 25 aircrafts operating to 15 destinations. The aircraft offers longer, wider full sleep seats.

KLM will be launching a twice weekly flight service to Luanda from the 14th November 2011. Flights will depart Schipol on a Monday and Friday and arrive in Luanda the same day and then the return service will depart that evening, arriving in Amsterdam the morning.

SAA and Mango has finalized a codeshare agreement between Lanseria and Cape Town, allowing SAA passengers to book codeshare flights operated by Mango between the two destinations. When travelling on Mango, SAA travelers still earn Voyager miles and receive snacks and beverages on-board.

SA Express announced a new direct route service between Cape Town and Kimberley effective 17 October 2011.

Heathrow is testing new "stickman" figure body scanners following concerns by passengers about privacy issues. The body scanners were tested at Melbourne Airport International in September 2011.

The President of Zambia has renamed three International Airports namely: Lusaka, Livingstone and Ndola International Airports. Lusaka International will be named, Kenneth Kaunda International, Livingstone will be called Harry Mwaanga Nkumbula Airport and Ndola will be called Simon Mwansa Kapwepwe Airport.

Embassies are rejecting passports when applying for visas due to passports not been signed on the last page.

The Australian Embassy are processing Tourist visa's in a turn-around time of 10 – 15 working days

Yellow Fever will be required for travel to Zambia as of October 1, as per the South African Department of Health.
